Literacy and Phonics

Maths


Here are some Maths activities for you to try at home!

This week we are going to be recapping place value within 50 and 3D shapes.

- It's time for a place value race! Ask a grown up to give you a number between 20-50. How many tens and ones does that number have? Can you draw or make the tens and ones? Who can make the amount first?
- It's time for a challenge! Ask a grown up to give you a calculation. What resources could you use to help you? Can you record the commutative calculation?
 $40+2=42$ $42=40+2$
- 3D shape hunt! Go on a shape hunt around your house or garden. What shapes can you find? Can you name them? How many edges and vertices do they have?
